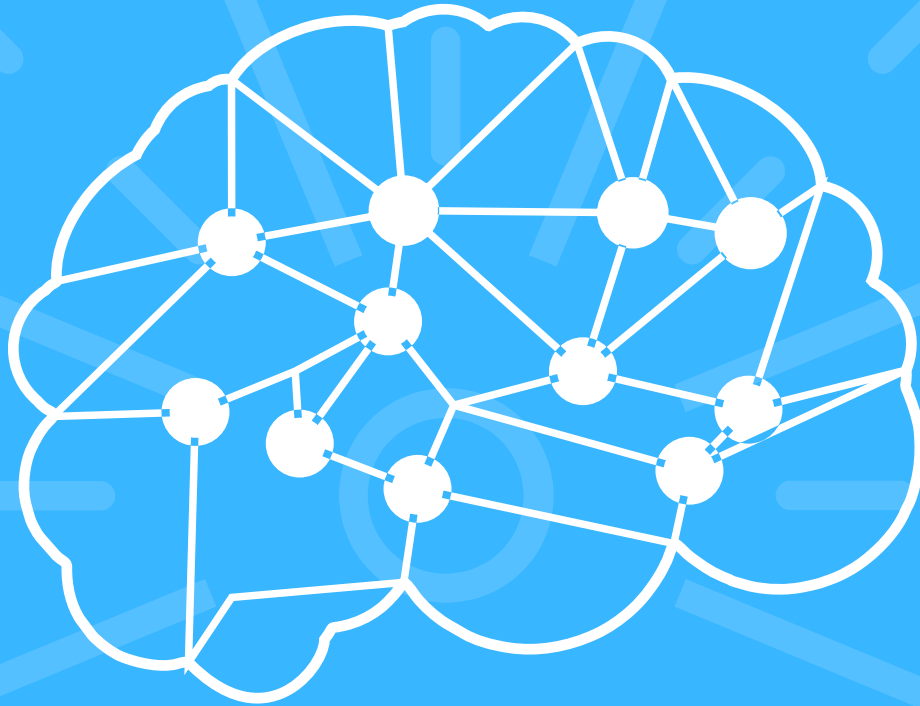

# DETAILS & TIPS

## APPLICATIONS

- Interested students must submit a short, accessible, summary of their research (250 words max). Summaries should be understandable to non-experts and the public.
- Your summary should include your name and which Neuroscience-focused 3000-level independent research project you are currently enrolled in.
- Summaries are due Sunday February 26th to [ESB@dal.ca](mailto:ESB@dal.ca)

## INVITATION TO PRESENT

- Based on the research summaries, up to 8 students will be invited to present at the SLAM Your Science event.
- Applicants will be notified by Friday March 3rd regarding their participation in the SLAM Your Science event.

## PRE-EVENT REQUIREMENTS

- Ahead of the event, slides/presentations must be sent to [ESB@dal.ca](mailto:ESB@dal.ca) no later than Monday March 13th.
- The presentations will be held in-person on Tuesday March 14th from 10:30-12:00pm with lunch served afterwards.
- The research supervisor for the student is encouraged to attend.
- Attendance for duration of entire event (1.5 hrs) is mandatory.

## PRESENTATION TIPS

- Slides should be kept to a minimum with an emphasis on high-impact visuals
- Presentations must describe the research you are currently and personally working on (be sure you have full permission from your PI/supervisor).
- Presentation must be no longer than 8 minutes (presenters will be cut off promptly at the 8-minute mark).
- Following the presentation, there will be up to 2 minutes for questions.
